School Menu

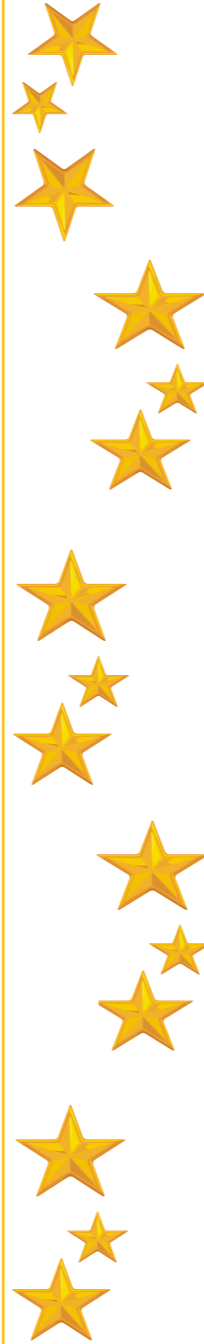
