## Greedy Pig



A game for 2 or more players

1. Roll a die - record the score.
2. Keep rolling and add the number to the last roll (keep a running total).

4. If a 6 is rolled at any point, then the game is over.
5. The winner is the person who sat down before the 6 roll.
