

# Create your own Hindu god!

LO: To edit a piece of descriptive writing.

Read your work aloud to someone in your family.

Can they spot anything you could improve or develop?

Ask them to read your work back to you.

Can you spot anything you could improve?

Use a colour pencil to underline the best parts.

Use a different colour to underline parts you could improve.

Remember to use relative clauses, fronted adverbials, and noun phrases.

Make sure your capital letters and punctuation are used correctly,

Your work should be organized in four paragraphs.

1. Physical description.
2. What do they ride?  
What do they carry?
3. What are they the god or goddess of?
4. Any other ideas.

Can you spot if any sentence is in the wrong paragraph?

Which is the best paragraph?

Which paragraphs need more work?

Can you add to any of the paragraphs?

Description (How many heads, etc.)

What do they ride? What do they carry?

What are they god or goddess of? (For example: fire, beauty, etc.)

Any other information (How were they born? Where do they live?)

Write out at least ONE paragraph again,  
with your added improvements.

If you really can't see anything that you can improve, use the  
time to start writing a legend about your Hindu god.

You could turn it into a comic book.

Comic strips tell stories in words and pictures.

We'll write our 'published' piece about your Hindu god  
on Friday in the classroom.
