

Maths

This half term we are focusing on multiplication and division focusing on 2s, 5s and 10s. Children will be exploring the concept behind these operations and representing problems using bar models, part whole models and as groups of objects.

Reading

We will explore the stories of a variety of authors and examine how their use of language makes great storytellers. There will be a particular focus on accuracy of spelling, punctuation and conjunctions. Children will be encouraged to use a range of vocabulary and use their reading to develop and influence their writing.

Science

We are currently looking at women who change dthe world through women scientists both today and in history. We are exploring how Mae Jemison changed the world by becoming the first black woman to travel into space as well as looking into the different fields of science to inspire us for a career in Science. We will explore the

Writing

We continue to use our writing skills to become more efficient writers. We are using the past tense to write recounts and continue to use time connectives in our writing ensuring that we use chronological order when retelling and sequencing stories.

PE

The daily physical challenges set for remote learning will help keep children active every day.

In school, in an 'Invasion Games' unit, children will further develop their understanding of the basic and fundamental principles of invasion games such as attacking, defending, scoring and teamwork. They will also recognise effective ways to find space and get away from an opponent.

History and Geography

We will learn about people who have changed the world throughout history. We will learn about the first black astronaut, Mae Jemison and the British astronaut Tim Peake. We will be learning about Diane Abbot and her importance in Britain.

Art

Music


This half term Year 2 are going to be songwriters! They will be using well known songs as the basis for a song of their very own. They will be developing their writing skills as well as their musical understanding.
