## Maths

This term we are looking at addition and subtraction of 1 and 2 digits numbers. We will then begin to learn about money and you can support this learning by making sure your child knows the value of each coin and discuss the concept of getting change. Students will then get introduced to Multiplication & Division by making and adding equal groups.

## Reading

In addition to daily phonics lessons, children will have an opportunity for targetted reading lessons to practice their segmenting, blending, fluency and comprehension skills during our reading lessons with the programme Read Write Inc. To support your child at home, you should hear them read for 20 minutes daily and discuss the story.

## Science

This half term we will be developing our skills of identifying and analysing our bodies. Children will learn about a healthy lifestyle including food groups and the importance of water. They will then design a balanced meal and a workout that will help them stay healthy.

## Music

This half term the children will be looking at the elements of music with a particular focus on rhythm, pitch and tempo. They will be investigating how these elements affect them as listeners.

## Writing

We will be writing a retell of stories linked to our unit 'Alive & Kicking'. We will continue to focus on forming sentences using capital letters and full stop, adjectives and conjunctions. This term we will learn how to use suffixes, punctuation and adverbs to make our writing more interesting.

# This half term in Year 2...

## History and Geography

During this unit, we will be identifying football teams across the globe, their locations and the history of football. We will also use a variety of sources to locate the world's continents and different countries. We will develop our skills in asking and answering geographical questions all linked to our Alive and Kicking unit.

## Religious Education

Our big question this term is 'Who is the Saint of our school?'. We will be visiting St John the Baptist Church to learn about St John's life. In the second half of the term, we will be discussing the symbol of light in relation to Jesus and Christianity.

## We are reading:

We will be reading *Hackney Martian*, *Spinderella*, *Little People* Marcus Rashford, *Do Goal Keeper's wear tiaras?* and *Kicking a Ball*.

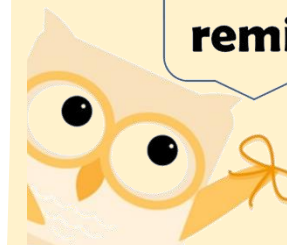
## Computing
