### Maths

This term we are continuing our explorations into fractions – using them to problem solve; finding fractions of amounts; ordering fractions and dividing them. We will be converting decimals, precentages and fractions, as well as revising our abilities on multiplying and dividing. We will look at translating shapes and plotting coordinates.

## Reading

We will begin by exploring and evaluating poetry and lyrics, looking at the authors intent. We will use our prediction and inference skills whilst reading Ghost Boys by Jewell Parker Rhodes as well as focusing on our deduction and retrieval skills whilst reading Room 13 by Robert Swindells. We will also spend a week examining the cross-curricular unit of the human body

## Science

Our topic this half term is the human body. We will explore how the circulatory system works and observe a heart dissection. We will make predictions and observations whilst conducting experiments into how exercise effects the human body

This half term Year 6 are travelling back in time

as they explore the evolution of music over time. They will gather inspiration from a variety of

genres to create their own unique compositions.

## Writing

As our topic is the NHS, we will be writing a formal letter to Sajid Javid in support of the NHS, and in recognition of it's need for more asistance in these times. We will be creating accounts of what it is like to be a doctor or nurse, and also exploring the story of 'A Monster Calls by Patrick Ness, which looks at the themes of illness and loss.

## This half term in Year 6...

## History and Geography

We will be looking at the establishment of the NHS, and how it has changed over time. We will compare our NHS to other medical services across the world. We will focus on Britain, and explore the counties and cities in it, and explore how our country is changing using historical and geographical sources.

## **Religious Education**

This term we are looking at Bhuddism and how a Bhuddist shows their faith. We will look at importnant symbols and doctrines, discuss the meaning of life, explore the Bhuddist Sangha and compare our own views and belefs to Bhuddism.
