Summer 2 2022

Maths

This term in Maths we are going to be exploring time by revisiting the basics specifically focusing on telling the time to the hour and half hour before looking at the two combined. We will then look more formally at measuring using standard units while revisiting the idea of mass and capacity.

Reading

Children will have an opportunity for targeted reading lessons to practice their segmenting, blending, fluency and comprehension skills during our reading lessons with the programme Read Write Inc. To support your child at home, you should hear them read for 20 minutes daily and discuss the story.

Science

In our science unit for this term we consider the beauty of nature and explore a range of habitats. We will explore three different habitats and define how different animals are suited to each environment. We look at sustainability, how to protect the world and the animals around us.

Music

This half term Year 2 will be getting ready for their summer performances. They will also be continuing with their keyboard skills, learning how to identify different notes on a keyboard.

Writing

Since September, the Year Two's have made great progress in their writing. We will continue to develop our writing this half term by learning to use suffixes, subordinating conjunctions, coordinating conjunctions and speech marks. We will be innovating stories linked to our unit 'Green World' to add our own twist and creativity.

This half term in Year 2...

History and Geography

The focus in Geography this term is our Green World, we will be exploring the world's fields and forests and the animals that live there whilst coming up with ways to protect these areas for the future. Students will also name, locate and identify different continents by exploring maps and satellite images of the UK and the world.

Religious Education

This term our big question is 'Why do Christians make promises to God?'. We will be discussing what communities we belong to and what it means to belong to a Christian community. We will be learning about promises made during a Christian baptism and a wedding.

Computing

In our computing lessons this term, students will learn how to research safely and successfully whilst choosing their own research topic to present at the end of the term.

Art

In our Art unit we will be focusing on sculptures. We will look at Benin Bronze sculptures and create our own clay piece at the end of the term.

We are reading:

We will be reading fiction stories and non-fiction books about nature, our environment and animals. Some of the books we will be reading are Little People Big Dreams Greta Thunberg, Tidy and Somebody Swallowed Stanley.
