Talk 4 Writing

Talk for write encourages the children to extend their vocabulary by recalling stories through story maps. As a class, we also create actions and use props to engage all learners. We will begin with the story Skin, which uses repetitive refrains to engage and support. The story also discusses how every person is different and special.

In RE this term we will be learning to understand our school's visions. We will begin with 'Love your neighbour as yourself', discussing what this means in our classroom environment and the wider school.

Art & Design

We are really excited to explore our creative area, experimenting with different materials and using them thoughtfully. We will develop our use of pastels, paint, collage and junk modelling. The children will be encouraged to discuss what they have made with others, using newly learned vocabulary to express themselves.

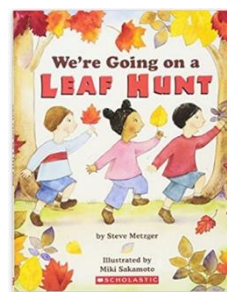
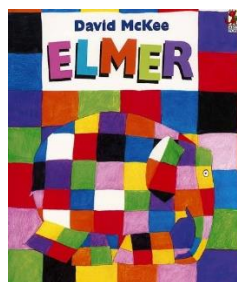

This half term we will be exploring numbers to gain a deep understanding of numbers to 10. This will enable the children to have mastery in their understanding of maths and develop a strong foundation to build upon. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes, comparing by height and beginning to look at AB patterns.
