Reading

In reading we will be getting up-to-date with facts and information by focusing on Infopedia 2024, with a focus on skimming and scanning a text for answers. We will also read Pig Heart Boy and use inference skills, as well as texts from the civil rights movement.

Writing

We will be writing narratives and accounts based on the word collector and Henry's Freedom Box. We will look at the life of Harriet Tubman and create a biography on her. Across these lessons, our grammar focuses will include: relative clauses; subordinate and co-ordinating conjunctions; parenthesis; colons and tenses.

Maths

In maths we will explore Bar Models and how this can be used to great effect to solve a variety of word problems. We will focus on the four main operations: Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and division.

RE

In R.E. we will be looking at how the Christian message has been spread for the last 2000 years. We will look at Jesus' and his disciples' roles in spreading this message and compare equivalencies to the modern day.

History / Geography

We shall be answering the question 'Why did people in Hackney give up sugar' by learning about the Transatlantic Slave Trade. We shall be mapping out which countries were involved, what experiences people had in this historical time and how Hackney has changed from the period of the Slave Trade.

Science

We will explore how nutrients and water are transported around the body, and learn about the impact of diet, lifestyle, drugs and exercise on the way the body functions.
