Maths

In Maths we will be converting between cm and mm in measures and practising counting in 100s and positioning 3-digit numbers on a number line before moving on to using known facts to add and subtract and measuring mass.

RE

In RE we will be answering the big question, How does the season of Advent and the feast of the Epiphany point towards the true meaning of Christmas?

Computing

In computing we will become bug fixers – we will use Scratch to identify bugs in coding and fix them.

PE days

PE this term is on **Tuesdays**. Please ensure children are wearing the correct kit for PE: house colour t-shirt, school jumper and navy joggers/leggings.

Reading

In reading we will be practising retrieving information from the text and reading books such as The Hodgeheg; Robin Hood and Grace & Family.

Writing

This half term in writing we are basing our work around our history, geography and science units. Children will learn how to write letters and retell the stories of famous figures such as Dina Asher Smith and Tanni Grey Thompson.

History / Geography

Our Yes, I can! Unit looks at the successes of women throughout sport. Focussing on key figures such as Dina Asher Smith, Tanni Grey Thompson and Wilma Rudolph, we will compare sports equipment from the past to today.

Science

In Science we will be looking at the impact exercise has on our bodies and considering the role vital organs and the skeleton have.
