Writing

In Writing, we're going to start off by looking at the Greek myth of The Minotaur as part of study of Ancient Athens where the children will use poetry to retell the story. Children are often scared of poetry but frequently amaze me with what they can produce! We will further explore our history topic by writing a recount of a trip to the early Olympic Games.

RE

Our Big Question this term is "How do Hindus worship?" It's an important part of the RE curriculum to learn about other religions and in this unit we will be looking at the history of the religion, how Hindus worship at home and the importance of pilgrimage.

Computing

In Computing, we will be exploring Scratch programming to create simple games and interactive quizzes. Scratch coding is a great way for the children to develop their algorithmic reasoning (and it's a lot of fun!)

PE this term is swimming on Wednesdays. Please ensure children come to school in the their PE kit to aid quick changing for swimming.

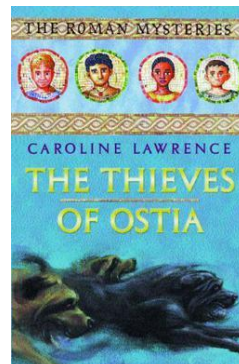
Reading

Maths

In Maths, we are continuing to look at patterns and reasoning based on multiplication and division. As always, a solid understanding of times tables will really help the children here, so please continue to support their learning with TT Rock Stars at home.

History / Geography

This Spring, our unit is based on 'The Rule of the People'. We will become historians and geographers by using a range of primary and secondary sources to ask questions about the start of democracy in Ancient Greece to the streets of Rome. We will be understanding how timelines work by creating our own and labelling key events. Then, we will compare the democracy in Ancient Greece and Rome with our current democracy.
