#### Writing

In writing this term all of our chosen texts are based around the idea of identity. We will be exploring a diverse range of hairstyles and using adjectives to describe. Children will follow the cycle of using the past tense to write a recount as well as developing narrative skills by retelling a story.

#### Reading

We will continue in our phonics groups, practising our skills such as segmenting and blending to read words. We will be reading a range of texts and answering comprehension questions about the book.

#### Maths

In maths this term we will be focusing on additive structures. We will be using aggregation to make a whole and learning that the addition symbol, +, can be used to represent aggregation. We will be learning about the equals symbol, =, and how it is used to show the equivalence between

the whole amount and the sum of the parts.

#### RE

Our new religion this term is Judaism. They will be learning about the religion through exploration of artefacts, class discussions and stories. Children will learn about Jewish celebrations and beliefs.



This half term in Year 1 we are thinking, learning CHURCH OF ENGLAND SCHOOL and remembering...


#### History / Geography


#### Computing
